TURNOUT OF OVERSEAS INDIANS IN LOK SABHA ELECTION LOW, SAYS EC

Context: Despite an increase in overseas Indians registering as electors for the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, turnout remained exceedingly low, prompting discussions on the need for alternative voting mechanisms like postal ballots or proxy voting to enhance participation.

MAJOR POINTS

- Registration and Turnout:
- Approximately 1.2 lakh overseas Indians registered as electors in 2024, a rise from 99,844 in 2019.
- o Actual voter turnout was minimal, with only 2,958 overseas electors participating, 90% of whom were from Kerala.
- o Large states like Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh, and Tamil Nadu reported zero turnout, while Gujarat and Maharashtra saw negligible participation.
- Challenges for NRI Voters:

- o Current laws require registered NRI voters to travel to their home constituencies in India to cast their votes, posing financial and logistical barriers.
- o Factors like high travel costs, work obligations, and educational commitments hinder participation.
- Proposals for Reform:
- o A 2018 Bill granting proxy voting rights to overseas Indians was passed in the Lok Sabha but stalled in the Rajya Sabha.
- o In 2020, the EC proposed extending the Electronically Transmitted Postal Ballot System (ETPBS) to overseas voters, but this proposal awaits government approval.

CONCLUSION:

The low voter turnout among overseas Indians highlights the urgent need for electoral reforms to facilitate their participation. Mechanisms like postal ballots or proxy voting could bridge this gap, ensuring that the growing number of registered NRI electors can actively contribute to India's democratic process.

CENTRE GETS 6.21 LAKH APPLICATIONS UNDER PM INTERNSHIP SCHEME

THE CHALLENGE OF HOLDING JUDGES ACCOUNTABLE

POLITY & GOVERNANCE

CONTEXT: The challenges in holding Indian judges accountable for misconduct, focus on the difficulties of the impeachment process and the limited success of past attempts. It highlights the case of Justice V. Ramaswami, who was found guilty by a committee but not removed by Parliament, and the resignation of Justice P.D. Dinakaran before the completion of impeachment proceedings, raising concerns about loopholes in the current system.

THE GIST

- Only two judges so far have been found guilty for their "misbehaviour" by the three-member committee, which must comprise of a Supreme Court judge, a Chief Justice of a High Court and an eminent jurist.
- Article 124 (4) of the Constitution stipulates that the panel's finding must be voted upon by Parliament. The motion requires either a two-thirds majority of present MPs voting in favour of the motion or an absolute majority in each House, for the judge to be removed.
- Such instances highlight that members of India's higher judiciary enjoy a disproportionately greater level of immunity when compared with even elected officials as they "continue to enjoy the perks of being a retired judge, like pension" and other benefits, said jurist Mohan Gopal.

KEY POINTS:

- Difficult Impeachment Process:
- o The process for removing a judge is complex and involves multiple stages, including a successful impeachment motion in Parliament and a subsequent inquiry by a three-member committee.
- o The high threshold for removal, requiring either a two-thirds majority of present MPs or an absolute majority in each House, makes it difficult to successfully impeach a judge.
- Limited Success:
- o Only two judges have been found guilty by the inquiry committee, and in both cases, the impeachment motion was either defeated in Parliament or the judge resigned before the process could be completed.
- This highlights the significant challenges in holding judges accountable for misconduct.
- Concerns Regarding Immunity:
- o Retired judges continue to enjoy significant benefits, including pensions, even if they are found guilty of misconduct.
- o This raises concerns about the level of immunity enjoyed by members of the judiciary compared to elected officials.
- Case Studies:
- o The case of Justice V. Ramaswami, who was found guilty of misconduct but not removed by Parliament, demonstrates the limitations of the impeachment process.
- o The resignation of Justice P.D. Dinakaran before the completion of the inquiry raised concerns about loopholes in the system, as it allowed him to avoid the consequences of the investigation.
- Need for Reform:
- o Experts, including jurist Mohan Gopal, have argued that the inquiry process should continue even if a judge resigns, to ensure accountability and prevent judges from avoiding scrutiny.
- o Reforms are needed to strengthen the mechanisms for holding judges accountable and ensure public confidence in the judiciary.

Conclusion:

The existing framework for holding Indian judges accountable presents significant challenges, including a complex and difficult impeachment process, limited success in past cases, and concerns regarding judicial immunity. These challenges raise serious questions about the effectiveness of the current system and the need for reforms to ensure greater transparency, accountability, and public trust in the judiciary.
